1. "Shall the Town appropriate the FY 2015-2016 budget of \$12,696,492 for municipal services, as adopted by the Charlestown Town Council on May 11, 2015?"

YES: 879

2. WARRANT QUESTION #1

"Shall the Town of Charlestown finance the acquisition, preservation or protection of open space or any interest therein alone or in conjunction with federal agencies, state agencies, land conservancies, land trusts or preservation organizations for preservation and approve the issuance of bonds and notes therefor in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000?"

3. WARRANT QUESTION #2

"Shall the Town of Charlestown, pursuant to the relevant provisions of section C-14 of the Town Charter, acting through the Town Council, be authorized to grant or transfer any conservation easement or easements on real property and improvements thereon known as Assessors Map 17, Lot 186 commonly known as the Charlestown Moraine Preserve (the "Preserve"), as may be necessary to ensure perpetual preservation of the Preserve?"

4. PETITION #1

"Shall the Town Treasurer and the President of the Charlestown Town Council be authorized pursuant to RIGL 45-12-2, to issue and refund from time to time, bonds, notes or other evidence of indebtedness in the amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) in order to finance the construction, furnishings, and/or equipping of recreational facilities, and/or other upgrades at Ninigret Park as outlined in the Ninigret Park Master Plan. The terms, details, and condition for such bonds, notes or other indebtedness to be set by resolution of the Town Council or by the Town Treasurer and the President of the Town Council in the absence of such resolution?"

Explanation: This referendum will allow the town to construct, furnish, and/or equip recreation facilities, and/or implement other upgrades in Ninigret Park. Example of items in the Master Plan include, but not limited to: A Sports Complex, Performing Arts Area, Festival Campground, Updated Little Nini Park, Improved Signage and Improved Interior Roads.
